

We now have a security gate at the entrance of the campground. Offering this additional level of safety and security to our campers and guests is something that has been on the Wakeda "To Do" list for several years, so we are excited to finally have been able to install it. We are working hard to make it as easy-to-use and minimally disruptive as possible. We appreciate your patience, especially at the beginning of the season, as we work out any potential kinks!

Here's how it works:

ARRIVALS DURING OFFICE HOURS:

- When arriving at Wakeda, please park to the right side of the parking lot in order to not block thru traffic for registered campers who are entering/leaving the campground.
- Please come into the office to register and obtain a sticker for your windshield.
- At this time, you will be issued **your own** gate PIN to gain access to the campground. DO NOT SHARE your unique PIN. If this policy is abused, you will be asked to leave. For the safety and security of all our guests, we need to know who is on the property.
- Any guests should follow the same procedure and will be issued their own PIN.
- If you are expecting any guests outside normal office hours it is critical that you inform the office, in advance, so arrangements can be made to provide them with access.

LATE ARRIVALS AFTER OFFICE CLOSES:

- When arriving at Wakeda, please park to the right side of the parking lot, in order to not block thru traffic for registered campers who are entering/leaving the campground.
- There is a Late Arrivals bulletin board on the front porch, where you will find a letter with your name on it that will contain the information necessary to temporarily gain access through the gate. You **MUST** return to the office by 10am the next morning to register and at that time will be provided with your personal security PIN which will be valid for your rest of your stay.

GATE INSTRUCTIONS:

- When you pull up to the gate, you will enter your unique PIN into the keypad to open the gate.
- No PIN is required to exit the property; the exit side of the gate will automatically open as vehicles approach.
- Please move slowly through the gate area to allow adequate time for the gates to fully open before driving through. The gate sensor will detect when there is no longer a vehicle in its path, so don't worry, it will not close on you!
- The gates only allow one vehicle through at a time, so each vehicle will need to enter a PIN upon entry. Exiting will take place one at a time – please be patient!

- The gate system is programmed to recognize emergency vehicles, so please rest-assured, its presence will not impede emergency response in any way.
- The gate is equipped with an intercom which will automatically connect to the security cell phone, should you encounter any issues outside of regular office hours.
